THE SEVEN (PART 7): Laodicea

Whether it is our talent, appearance, or our perceived social acumen, we often suffer from a Perception that is not always in line with Reality.

Revelation 3:14-22

- 14 "To the angel of the church in Laodicea write: These are the words of the Amen, the faithful and true witness, the ruler of God's creation.
- 15 I know your deeds, that you are neither cold nor hot. I wish you were either one or the other!
- 16 So, because you are lukewarm—neither hot nor cold—I am about to spit you out of my mouth.
- 17 You say, 'I am rich; I have acquired wealth and do not need a thing.'
 But you do not realize that you are wretched, pitiful, poor, blind and naked.
- 18 I counsel you to buy from me gold refined in the fire, so you can become rich; and white clothes to wear, so you can cover your shameful nakedness; and salve to put on your eyes, so you can see.
- 19 Those whom I love I rebuke and discipline. So be earnest and repent.
- 20 Here I am! I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears my voice and opens the door, I will come in and eat with that person, and they with me.
- 21 To the one who is victorious, I will give the right to sit with me on my throne, just as I was victorious and sat down with my Father on his throne.
- 22 Whoever has ears, let them hear what the Spirit says to the churches."

I. Laodicean Christians assumed they were doing great spiritually, but this letters says they were not.

A. History on Laodicea:

- Laodicea was actually a CROSSROADS for this whole part of the world.
- Laodicea had one of the most important Medical Colleges of the Ancient world.
- So Laodicea had a total monopoly on the textile industry and there was great wealth and opportunity in the area related to that.
- Laodicea was a huge banking center.
- Life in Laodicea tended to be very prosperous and relatively easy.
- Laodicean Christians were very casual about God.

I wonder how often the role I assign God in my own life could be more likened to a Rich Uncle than my Source, Savior, or Lord.

A sense of Self Sufficiency in Life Can Cause a Casual, Lukewarm Love for God.

- That kind of dispassionate religion brought a sharp response from Jesus.
- We sometimes suffer the misconception that God is happy to get whatever part of our lives we are willing to offer him.

III. Problem: Casual Religion creates a Relational Imbalance with God.

- John 3:16 For God SO LOVED the world that he GAVE HIS ONE AND ONLY SON.
- Hebrews 12:2 says that Jesus, "for the joy set before him endured the cross Scorning its shame."
- A. There is nothing God has done for you that is sensible, measured, or casual.
- B. When someone loves you with such reckless generosity, the only response that is not a mockery of it, is to reply in kind.
 - Matthew Henry: "If religion is worth anything it is worth everything, and indifference here is inexcusable."

IV. Love can only truly be appreciated and reciprocated when we recognized that it is undeserved.

- A. The solutions to this church's lukewarm love was for Jesus to show them the reality of what they were.
 - -Wretched -Pitiful -Poor -Blind -Naked
- B. That is a remarkable idea: To be fully known and to still be fully loved.
- C. The answer is not a what it is a who! Jesus
 - He knocks, he will come in, he will partner with you
 - But he will not live in this Relational Imbalance

Jesus is knocking, but not for scraps or leftovers, he is not interested in that awkward Relational Imbalance, but if you will open the door to be reminded of his love for you, it will Ignite a proper response in you to him.
