### **REDEEM THE TIME:** The Days are Evil

There are so many things in our lives that we know to be askew.

Problem: Many times we wait for some Magic Moment in the Future when we think it will be easier to address our issues.

### Ephesians 5:15-17

- 15 Be very careful, then, how you live—not as unwise but as wise,
- 16 making the most of every opportunity, because the days are evil.
- 17 Therefore do not be foolish, but understand what the Lord's will is.
- I. When areas of life are in disarray, Procrastination only further cements them that way.
  - A. God's plan is not for us to be ruled by circumstances, like a boat drifting on a current.
  - B. God gives us the Oars and Rudders of wisdom, care, and opportunity so that we can shape and direct our circumstances as we pass through them.
  - C. Young's Literal Translation says it like this:

### Ephesians 5:15-16

- 15 See, then, how exactly ye walk, not as unwise, but as wise
- 16 redeeming the time, because the days are evil
- Redeem: By payment of a price to recover from the power of another, to ransom.
- D. If we do our part, then God has made a way for the passage of time to improve our circumstances rather than deteriorate them.
- II. Time left to its own will Scatter Opportunity, but God calls us to gather.
  - A. There are 3 key thoughts in this scripture that explain what it looks like to Live in a way that Redeems Time:
    - Careful Wise Understanding the Lord's Will

- Be Careful: In this context "Be careful" means be thoughtful and deliberate in what you are doing and how you are living.
  - Don't live a Reactionary life. Be Proactive.
- 2) Not as Unwise, but as Wise
  - There are so many things that you are technically allowed to do, but they are Folly.
  - What we should be asking is, "Based on current circumstances, what is the Wise thing to do?"
  - Wisdom does not ask what it can do or what it is allowed to do.
  - Wisdom asks what would be best to do.
- 3) Understand what the Lord's Will Is
  - This is living with the understanding that God has a Plan for your life.
    - Sometimes there are many options that could all be good and could all be wise.
    - So from there, there is another step of learning to DISCERN God's direction for specific action in your life.

## III. God has entrusted so much to our stewardship; it is vital that we make the most or our opportunities.

- A. That verse tells us to make the most of every opportunity. But what does an opportunity look like?
- B. The key to Redeeming the Time; The Key to your life BEING BLESSED and BEING THE BLESSING God Intends:
  - Make the most of the days you are given.
