

Looking...Ahead?

I. The idea of Substantive Self Improvement

James 4:13-15

- 13 Now listen, you who say, "Today or tomorrow we will go to this or that city, spend a year there, carry on business and make money."
- 14 Why, you do not even know what will happen tomorrow. What is your life? You are a mist that appears for a little while and then vanishes.
- 15 Instead, you ought to say, "If it is the Lord's will, we will live and do this or that."

Psalm 127:1

Unless the Lord builds the house, those who build it labor in vain. Unless the Lord watches over the city, the watchman stays awake in vain.

- Human work was intended to be a combination of our action and God's direction.
 - A. When it comes right down to it, futile and pointless actions can be traced back to a lack of Divine direction.
 - B. As God pours into you it is supposed to be formative and directive for what then flows out of you.
- III. Before we focus on tomorrow, it is helpful to remember what God did yesterday.
 - A. At significant moments, when God worked on Israel's behalf, God would instruct them to build something lasting in that place as a reminder of what he did.
 - B. What you are willing to believe God for is very different in the light of what he has already done!
 - C. You will know that you have looked back long enough when you can no longer restrain yourself from dreaming about what might be ahead.
- IV. A God-shaped vision for our future is less about specific goals and more about an imagination for the possibilities inherent when Godly direction is coupled with faith-filled action.

V. Besides lacking a memory of God's goodness, our other issue is that we sometimes lack Divine direction.

- A. Jesus told Peter, "Your spirit is willing but your flesh is weak." (Matthew 26:41)
- B. When our spiritual activity level exceeds our spiritual input level for too long, our efforts become hollow and fruitless.
- C. Burnout is not the result of too much activity. It is the result of too much futility.
- D. When action exceeds revelation, the solution is an increased discipline in the 3 P's: Pray, Pursue, Party.
- E. Your ability to LIVE FOR God and DO FOR God are dependent on His continual fresh revelation in your life.
